Short instructions starting your master's thesis project with AYJ

All master's thesis follow the same structure - <u>have a look at earlier master's thesis</u> - you can find 30++ MSC thesis examples in my home page, all them are good examples.

If you work in a company or project, <u>find an instructor</u> (who is MSc, can help you in defining the topic, and is willing to help you on a weekly basis in your master's thesis project).

Think about the topic you have in mind with your instructor and make a draft in a format of the <u>Introduction chapter of the master's thesis</u> including: <u>general introduction</u> (also called motivation) to the topic, <u>problem statement</u>, and <u>structure of the thesis</u>. These are the mandatory parts of the Introduction chapter in the master's thesis.

I encourage you to write a draft of the Introduction chapter before our first meeting.

For some topics it is logical to separately describe in the Introduction subjects as objectives, methodology, research questions, etc. You can see examples in the earlier master's thesis and you can decide are they logical for your thesis structure.

Once you have such an initial idea of the possible master's thesis topic, please contact me to discuss the <u>feasibility of the topic</u> and the <u>schedule and objectives</u> of your master's thesis project.
